



EXPECTATIONS FOR E-LEARNING AND REMOTE STUDENTS 2020

Students are to behave respectfully and maturely during any distance learning. This means that any behavior during a live class, recorded class and/or anything submitted for any school related activity, must be in line with the BCA code of conduct, as defined by the Parent/Student handbook.

- Violations of the codes of conduct will be handled by the Principal.
- The Technology Responsible Use policy guidelines, as outlined in a separate document, are still in effect.
- Students are expected to practice good health, good hygiene, and wear clothing that reflects the moderation and spirit of our school.
- The full BCA dress code will not be in force. Students are expected to show the same level of respect for the learning environment as if they were going to the classroom

Students must adhere to the following during any Zoom, or other video conference, for school.

- Students should sit upright at a desk, table, or other designated workspace in a quiet area with all appropriate materials
- Turn off or disconnect from non-academic distractions including, but not limited to, music, TV, games, social media, texting, or other cell phone use, during academic time .
- Video camera stays on and students face should be clearly visible on the screen when present in school activity or class. Students may turn their video off, only with permission of the teacher.

Do not eat during class.

Use the restroom before class.

Virtual backgrounds are only allowed at the teachers discretion.
