2021-2022 Annual Tuition/Fundraising/Fees Schedule

Family Tuition – Kindergarten - 8th Grade:

One student per family	\$ 5200
Two students per family	\$ 7850
Three students per family	\$ 9570
Four or more students per family	\$ 9975

3yr and 4yr Pre-Kindergarten:

One student \$ 5650

*Discount will be applied if other siblings attend in grades K-8

Family Fundraising Obligation (All Grades):

One student per family: \$500 per family

Two or more students per family: \$650 per family

Student Fees:

Registration fee per student \$125, New Student \$150

Curriculum/material fee per Pre-K through 8th grade student \$ 275

*** Registration and Curriculum/Material fees need to be paid at the time of registration for new students, PreK-8th grade.**

*** All student fees are non-refundable.**

Notes:

-**Tuition assistance money** (based upon need) is available from Big Shoulders. During the 2020-2021 school year, several BCA families requested assistance from the Big Shoulders Fund and most received some tuition aid.

Any year-ending account credit balances will be rolled into your account for the following year, or refunded upon request.

-In the event that BCA needs to, or decides to restrict any enrollment, your timeliness and history of account payments will be considered.
